The contractor should be authorized by the roofing manufacturer to install its products, and trained to install them correctly and according to specifications. Commercial roof system manufacturers typically have established quality rating systems and recognition programs to ensure that the contractors selling and installing their roof products are qualified and proficient.

Regardless of their size, commercial roofs are complex assemblies and all re-roof projects require extensive pre-planning and preparation. This might include cutting into the current roof surface to determine the condition of the underlying insulation and deck; it's possible that these components may need to be repaired or replaced as part of the project. The contractor should also do "pull tests" in the roof assembly to help determine the correct fastener for the job. After a thorough evaluation of the current roof is conducted, the contractor should share findings with you and answer any questions to make sure that everyone involved is on the same page.

The contractor should have a solid reputation in the community and provide references of satisfied customers. Ideally, the contractor will have completed jobs that are comparable to the new one under consideration, as different rooftops have different requirements. For example, restaurant roofs with multiple penetrations are significantly different from warehouse roofs that typically have wide open spaces.

Perhaps the most important thing to know ahead of time is whether you feel confident that your new roof will provide years of worry-free, watertight protection for your commercial building. A new commercial roof installation is a big investment and it should be backed by a solid manufacturer's warranty and a commitment from the contractor that they will stand behind their workmanship.
